PTAP is offered exclusively through a partnership with Universal Technical Institute, which supplies instructors and helps identify and recruit top automotive students across the country. Since its inception in 1999, PTAP has graduated over 1,000 technicians, placing them in full-time roles at more than 200 Porsche Centers across the U.S. With demand for skilled technicians at an all-time high, PTAP graduates enjoy stable, well-paying careers in a high-demand industry.

Training takes place at PCNA's state-of-the-art facilities in Atlanta, Easton, Pennsylvania and Eastvale, California. With a 12:1 student-to-instructor ratio, PTAP offers personalized instruction and hands-on experience with Porsche vehicles ranging from the iconic 911 to the Macan Electric. Graduates typically achieve Bronze Certification within their first year, positioning them for long-term success in Porsche Centers nationwide.

Porsche covers tuition and housing and provides part-time employment opportunities during training.
